Capitol Rally Supports Correctional and Police Officers

March 24, 2017 – Supporters of Delaware correctional and police officers gathered in Dover Wednesday for the "302 Back Our Blue Rally."

The group met at the Dover Police Department and then marched several blocks to Legislative Mall for the 4 p.m. event.

The chronic issues of short-staffing, forced overtime, and difficult working conditions of the state prison system's staff have been getting close examination following the February 1st uprising at the James T. Vaughn Correctional Center near Smyrna that resulted in the murder of correctional officer, Lt. Steven Floyd.
