**Reforming a Law  
Preventing Job  
Creation, Economic  
Development**

**JUNE 24, 2019** -- Delaware law forbids a single owner from operating any more than three brew-pubs in the state, while neighboring Pennsylvania and Maryland have no such restrictions.



State Rep. Bryan Shupe, R-Milford South, is sponsoring [legislation](#) to lift the cap, removing what he believes is a barrier to job creation.

Last Wednesday (6/19), the House Economic Development/Banking/Insurance & Commerce Committee heard from brew-pub operators who indicated they want to grow their businesses in Delaware, but will be forced to look outside the state unless the law is changed.
