## **Vehicle Tags Celebrate State Fair's 100th Anniversary**

Motorists who wish to support the Delaware State Fair will soon be able to do so. Thursday evening, Gov. John Carney signed into law [Senate Bill 185](#), authorizing the creation of the Delaware State Fair Centennial license plate.

The fair will mark its 100th anniversary next year.

The limited edition plates will cost \$100. After the standard state vehicle fees are paid, the remaining proceeds will benefit the Delaware State Fair.

State Sen. Gary Simpson, R-Milford, sponsored the legislation along with State Reps. Bobby Outten, R-Harrington; Harvey Kenton, R-Milford; and Dave Wilson, R-Cedar Creek Hundred. All four legislators are members of the Delaware State Fair Board of Directors. The measure cleared both chambers of the General Assembly on unanimous votes.
