

# Last “Cup of Joe with Joe” Meeting for 2008 Slated

The public’s last chance this year to come to one of State Rep. Joe Booth’s (R-Georgetown) regular coffee meetings is quickly approaching.

The final “*Cup of Joe with Joe*” meeting for 2008 will take place in Georgetown on Thursday, Dec. 11<sup>th</sup>.

The Cup of Joe with Joe meetings give residents of the 37<sup>th</sup> District a regular chance to speak with their state representative over a free cup of coffee. The meetings are held monthly in both Georgetown and Lewes on the second and fourth Thursdays of the month, respectively.

There will be no meetings in Lewes for the remainder of the year because the prospective dates fall on Thanksgiving and Christmas.

The last Georgetown meeting will be held at its usual location: the Georgetown Family Restaurant (115 E. Market Street) between 9 a.m. and 10 a.m. “This is the last opportunity constituents will have to attend one of my meetings before the 145<sup>th</sup> General Assembly session gets underway,” Rep. Booth said.

The new legislative session begins on January 13<sup>th</sup>.

“There has been a lot of turmoil over the last few months and the recent elections have changed the political landscape,” Rep. Booth said. “Additionally, the slowing economy will create difficult challenges for us as we face a sharp drop in state revenues in the upcoming year. There will certainly be a lot to talk about. I’ll have to ask the folks at the Georgetown Family Restaurant to make a few extra pots of coffee.”

The Cup of Joe with Joe meetings in Lewes will resume on Thursday, January 22<sup>nd</sup> at the normal venue: Cafe Azafran, 109 Market Street, between 9 a.m. and 10 a.m.
