**STATE LAWMAKERS CEREMONIALLY MARK THE
TRANSFER OF A DELAWARE NATIONAL GUARD BUILDING
TO THE CITY OF HARRINGTON**

State Rep. Shannon Morris and Senator Dave Wilson today were joined by City of Harrington officials for an event to ceremonially mark the transfer of the National Guard's vehicle storage facility to Harrington.

The event was held at the Delaware National Guard Armory (located at 114 East Liberty Street, Harrington, DE 19952).

Over the course of the past year, Rep. Morris and Senator Wilson have been advocating for the transfer of the facility to the City of Harrington.

The transfer of the building, authorized in January as part of the legislature's "mini" Bond Bill, is needed in order to provide more space to the City of Harrington's Parks and Recreation department. Through the enactment of House Bill 290, Parks and Recreation will be able to offer more programs, thereby creating more opportunities for citizens in the Harrington area to enjoy meaningful events and recreational activities.
